General Information for International Undergraduate Applicants

Deadlines for Admission: Your Application for Admission will be processed as soon as it is received (along with the processing fee, if applicable) by the Office of Immigration and International Admissions. However, an admission decision cannot be made until all official required supporting documents are received. The dates for admission are listed below. Early application is strongly encouraged.

Application Processing Fee: A non-refundable processing fee of \$45 is required with the submission of the paper admissions application. The online admissions application fee is \$35. You may apply online at <http://www.southalabama.edu/apply>. The application fee is valid for one calendar year. Returning undergraduate students should complete the Readmission Application for procedures and deadlines.

Supporting Documents: It is the responsibility of the student to request all required official supporting documents (i.e., transcripts, test scores, etc.) be sent directly from the institution(s) or testing agency to the Office of Immigration and International Admissions. A separate transcript is required from each institution attended. Academic records not in English must be accompanied by a certified translation. All prior enrollment information will be verified by the National Student Clearinghouse.

English Proficiency for Nonnative Speakers: A minimum score on the one of the following is required for admissions:

- TOEFL - minimum score 61
- IELTS - minimum score 5.5
- iTEP - minimum score 3.6
- Pearson (PTE) - minimum score 44
- ACT - minimum 19 English subscore
- SAT - minimum 24 Reading Test score
- A Level - minimum grade of C on English Examination

Transfer Students: International students (F-1) applying as transfer students from institutions within the United States must submit a completed Transfer Eligibility form.

Additional Information: A photocopy of your passport must be sent to the Office of Immigration and International Admissions.

Financial Information: A notarized financial affidavit and a certified bank statement for at least \$31,243 U.S (based on nine (9) months).

Estimated Expenses: These amounts are subject to change without notice. Students who will be accompanied by a dependent will need, in addition to the above, \$5,000 in funds for the first dependent and \$3,000 for each additional dependent.
